

Present Simple v. Continuous

Put the verbs in brackets into the *Present Simple* or the *Present Continuous*.

Example:

He usually *watches* (watch) television alone, but today he *is watching* (watch) television with his friends.

4. I *do not understand* (not understand). What *are you talking* (you, talk) about?
5. I *hear* (hear) you *are leaving* (leave) soon. Is it true?
6. Monica *is studying* (study) Maths this year, but she *does not like* (not like) it very much.
7. Please be quiet. I *am trying* (try) to study.
8. Dustin always *listens* (listen) to classical music while he *is resting* (rest).
9. You can use my pen if you *like* (like). I *do not need* (not need) it at the moment.
10. Susan *is spending* (spend) this weekend in Coimbra. She usually *goes* (go) there every week.
11. The woman who *is talking* (talk) to the children *lives* (live) on the second floor of this building.
