June 2012 Past Simple (irregular verbs)

Write the verbs in the Past Simple (affirmative, negative or interrogative).

Example: I **did** (do) the homework.

1. How many glasses of water (you/drink)?
I (drink) two glasses of water. What about you?
I (not drink) any water. I
(not be) very thirsty.

2. What (you/do) last night?
I (go) to the cinema.
What (you/see)?
I (see) a horror film. And you?
We (have) dinner in a restaurant and
(drink) some wine.
..... (you/go) somewhere after that?
No, we We (go) straight home.

3. He (drive) all the way to the station and
..... (catch) a train to London.

4. The sun (rise) very early in the morning and
..... (shine) all day long. The wind
(blow) gently and the birds (fly) across the sky.

5. The man (steal) the money and
(run) away.

6. (she/write) the letter?
Yes, she (write) it and (send) it
the following day.

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7. I (find) the money and (give) it back to the owner.
8. (you/sell) the house you (buy) last year?
No, I I (sell) the one I (have) for ten years.
9. John (wake) up at 6.00 and (not get) up until 6.30. Then he (have) breakfast at about 7.00 and (leave) the house just before 7.20.

3. He **drove** (drive) all the way to the station and **caught** (catch) a train to London.
4. The sun **rose** (rise) very early in the morning and **shone** (shine) all day long. The wind **blew** (blow) gently and the birds **flew** (fly) across the sky.
5. The man **stole** (steal) the money and **ran** (run) away.
6. **Did she write** (she/write) the letter?
Yes, she **wrote** (write) it and **sent** (send) it the following day.
7. I **found** (find) the money and **gave** (give) it back to the owner.
8. **Did you sell** (you/sell) the house you **bought** (buy) last year?
No, I **didn't**. I **sold** (sell) the one I **had** (have) for ten years.
9. John **woke** (wake) up at 6.00 and **didn't get** (not get) up until 6.30. Then he **had** (have) breakfast at about 7.00 and **left** (leave) the house just before 7.20.
