1. John **is studying** (study) at the moment. He **isn't playing** (not play) with his friends.
2. Is Mrs. Smith in? Yes, she **is watching** (watch) television.
3. **Are you cooking** (you/cook)? No, I **am not**. I **am washing** (wash) the dishes.
